



On behalf of the Blair Atholl Golf Team, it's our pleasure to welcome you to Blair Atholl. Blair Atholl Golf Club is the former home of golfing legend and 9-time Major Champion, Mr. Gary Player.

The course is naturally designed by Mr. Player and bears his signature ranking 4th best course in South Africa and the best course in Gauteng.. Blair Atholl was also the former home of 2011 Masters Champion, Mr. Charl Schwartzel.

Blair Atholl proudly hosted the 2022 and 2023 Investec SA Open Championship, a DP World Tour Event, where two local champions were crowned, Thriston Lawrence and Dean Burmester respectively.

As a Private Members Club we uphold the traditions and etiquette of golf and we ask you please familiarize yourself with the club rules prior to your arrival. The course is challenging and is the 2nd longest golf course in the world off the Black Pro tees (7523 meters or 8227 yards). However, there are 5 sets of tees so you can choose a course that suits your game best: Black (for pros and low handicap golfers), Gold (low Handicaps, challenging), Silver (Men's club tee), Bronze (Men's forward tee, suitable for shorter hitters), White (shortest course) Blair Atholl has trained caddies available, 1 caddie / spotter per 4 ball is required.

The caddie fee is R300 minimum plus gratuity (please bring cash) or e-wallet. The club supply caddies' halfway lunch and no tip is required from guests at halfway house. Please note that outside caddies are NOT permitted. Outside golf carts are not permitted to be brought into the estate.

NB: The consumption of alcohol on the course and practice facilities is strictly prohibited We thank you for your co-operation and accepting the challenge of playing Blair Atholl.

BLAIR ATHOLL GOLF CLUB DRESS CODE

The Blair Atholl Golf Club follows the strong traditions of the game of golf as well as standards set for private Members premium golfing facilities such as Blair Atholl. Golfers are therefore required to dress appropriately in recognized golfing attire at all times. The authority is given to the Director of Golf and his appointed staff to decide what is appropriate for the club. We ask for your co-operation to avoid unpleasant situations and to adhere to this policy.

General

Golf shirts to be tucked in at all times.

Recognized Golf Shoes only permitted on course (no steel spikes allowed).

Gentleman: No Flip Flops, Crocs or Open Sandals after Midday (12pm) in the clubhouse and outside patio areas.

No Cargo styled side pocket shorts or longs allowed.

No apparel with bold advertising, big logos or large numerals.

Non-Golfers may accompany guests on a golf cart providing they are similarly appropriately dressed. Permission must be granted by the Director of Golf prior to play.

Clubhouse Men

Caps and headwear must be removed whilst inside the Highlander Bar or main dining room area.

Golf shoes with soft spikes permitted.

No flip flops, Crocs or open sandals permitted after 12pm in the clubhouse or patio areas, Casual shoes with closed heels are permitted after golf.

Regular Golf shirts, formal shirts after golf permitted. Shirts with bold advertising, logos and large numerals are not permitted. Shirts with inappropriate wording are not permitted.

Clubhouse Ladies

Appropriate length golf shorts, longs and skirts permitted.

Traditional collared, crew neck and sleeveless golf shirts are permitted, waist length styled shirts may not be tucked in.

No bold numerals, logos or advertising on any apparel. Formal, casual shoes or sandals are permitted at the clubhouse.
